02 Biography

Shumo AG is a 14-year-old Australian singer-songwriter and multi-instrumentalist based in Brisbane, building an international audience through original music, major live performances and cross-market collaboration.

He began writing and performing music at age eight and has since written more than 25 original songs — 17 officially released as of September 2026 — spanning pop, pop-rock, indie rock and melodic rock. He has extensive studio recording experience and independently arranges his own material, taking songs from initial idea through vocal and instrumental recording to full studio production. An accomplished vocalist, guitarist and pianist, he brings strong musicianship to his songwriting, recording and live performances.

His live experience already includes audiences of up to 40,000 people, from MTV Asia School Fest to major stages in Vietnam and Indonesia. In 2026, he performed as Teen Ambassador for Sukin Australia on Opening Day of the Brisbane International Tennis Tournament, and took part in more than 40 school performances across bands, orchestras and ensembles during 2025–2026 — staying closely involved in his school music community even as his professional profile has grown.

"Shumo remained the sole credited songwriter on the officially released collaborative version of Iron Veins" — despite the song becoming a major Australia–Indonesia collaboration.

Rather than building his identity through covers or songs written for him, Shumo is developing a growing body of original work built around his own melodies, lyrics and expressive electric guitar playing. His songs explore family, vulnerability, resilience, growing up, relationships and hope — themes that run through both his highest-profile release ("Iron Veins") and his most personal, still-unreleased song ("MOM", see page 6).

In 2026 he was selected with a songwriting scholarship for Prodigy Camp, USA — an alumni network that includes GRAMMY-winning artist Chappell Roan — and named Youth Patron of the Next Up Music Awards (2026–27) alongside industry Patrons Sia and Troye Sivan. He is currently writing new material and working toward a debut album planned for release by the end of 2027.

Artist identity

Shumo's music moves between emotionally driven pop-rock, indie influences and contemporary pop — combining personal storytelling, strong melodic hooks and guitar-led musicianship. Electric guitar is his main instrument and a defining part of his sound, but his musicianship extends well beyond it: he is also a vocalist who plays cello in his school symphony orchestra, with acoustic guitar and piano forming a major part of his songwriting process. As his international audience grows, he continues to expand his sound while keeping songwriting, musicianship and live performance at the centre of his identity.

03 International momentum — "Iron Veins" × Batas Senja

"Iron Veins" began as an original song written independently by Shumo. What makes it significant is the journey it has taken — from a young songwriter's own composition to a major international collaboration, while Shumo remained the sole credited songwriter on the officially released collaborative version.

The song caught the attention of Indonesian hitmakers Batas Senja, one of Indonesia's leading bands with approximately 9.5 million monthly Spotify listeners. Over several months, the two artists reimagined "Iron Veins" as an Australia–Indonesia collaboration, reshaping the arrangement toward Batas Senja's pop-rock and folk roots while preserving Shumo's original songwriting, emotional core, guitar work and artistic identity. It was released on 5 June 2026.

The collaboration gave the song a life far beyond its original form — connecting young Australian songwriting with a major Southeast Asian audience. Coverage followed across Australia, Indonesia, the US, the UK, Vietnam and other territories, including a feature on 7NEWS Australia. In July 2026, Shumo travelled to Indonesia for a radio and TV promotional tour with Batas Senja and performed "Iron Veins" live with the band in front of an audience of approximately 40,000 people.

A song independently written by a 14-year-old Australian songwriter became the foundation of a major cross-cultural collaboration — reimagined for a new language and audience, covered by international media, and performed to roughly 40,000 people.

At its heart, "Iron Veins" explores emotional armour, vulnerability and the point at which the strength we build to protect ourselves can begin to isolate us. "Iron" is used as a metaphor for that armour, with the song moving from restraint and isolation into an explosive desire to break free, reconnect and feel again.

Two versions

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04 **What's next — "Young Boy, Young Girl"**

Building on the momentum of "Iron Veins," Shumo is preparing his next original release, "Young Boy, Young Girl" — a high-energy pop track introducing a more playful, commercially driven side of his songwriting. Built around a memorable "Young Boy / Young Girl" hook, the song takes a humorous look at young relationships and the excuses teenagers make when parents catch them together.

Musically, the track carries Shumo's emotional pop-rock and singer-songwriter roots into a contemporary dance-pop direction. The release is being developed as an international campaign combining short-form content, creator collaborations, live performances and promotional activity across the US, Australia and key Asian markets.

06 Feature song — "Mom" (unreleased)

"Mom" is an unreleased original song written by Shumo for his mother, planned for inclusion on his debut album (targeted for release by the end of 2027). Even before its official release, it has developed a remarkable life on stage — performed at major live concerts in Vietnam and Indonesia to audiences of approximately 15,000–40,000 people, and used by 7NEWS Australia in a television feature about Shumo, introducing the song to a wider Australian audience.

The song reflects on childhood, unconditional love and the bittersweet realisation that growing up changes the relationship between a parent and child. What makes it especially distinctive is the arrangement: alongside his main instrument, electric guitar, Shumo plays cello in his school symphony orchestra and created the cello arrangement for "Mom" himself — the cello acting almost like a second emotional voice, adding warmth and a classical dimension to a contemporary ballad. As with his other material, Shumo recorded all instrumental parts and vocals himself and undertook the pre-mixing, making the recording a particularly personal representation of his own musical vision.

07 **Live performance**

Performance is a major part of Shumo's development as an artist. While still in his early teens, he has already performed on major international stages, developing not only technical skill but the stage presence and adaptability to connect with large, culturally diverse audiences.

Beyond guitar and vocals, Shumo plays cello in his school symphony orchestra and uses acoustic guitar and piano as core songwriting tools. He works from his home studio in Cubase, recording his own vocals and instrumental parts, developing arrangements and undertaking pre-mixing before tracks move to later production — involvement that spans songwriting, arrangement, performance, recording and preparation for final production.
